In 2019, Larry continued to excel, producing Kany Garcia's "Contra El Viento," which won him a Latin Grammy for "Recording Engineer of the Year" and was considered

for "Best Singer-Songwriter Album." He also produced "Perfecta" for Sony Music artist Marger and collaborated with Universal recording artist Pitizion on "Tu Ultima Canción." His work on Manu Manzo's "Apaga La Luz" and Christian Pagán's "Quiero" further solidified his status in the industry.

Larry's continued success includes writing and producing for Proyecto 1, showcasing his enduring talent in the music scene with tracks like "Chanceame" and "Y tu peleas." His involvement with Kerreke's second album, debuting their single "Nuestro Juramento" in November 2019, highlights his ongoing influence and creativity in music production.
